Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Ruthie Maslin.

Minutes of the June 30, 2020 Executive Committee were reviewed and approved.

Jenni Link gave a financial report that indicated KPLA was in good financial position despite having to cancel the Spring 2020 conference.

Mark Adler gave an update on KLA's transition to self-management, with a go-live date of late November for the new management software, MemberClicks.

Lindsay Westerfield gave an update on progress for the KPLA 2021 conference. A decision will be made in early December about whether to go all virtual or attempt a hybrid conference.

A motion was made to purchase a subscription to Bit.ai in order for Michael Richter's ad hoc committee to continue work on developing a knowledge repository for KPLA.

Individual KPLA committees were discussed:

- o Intellectual Freedom- needs a new chair
- Standards Committee- new standards should be released at KPLA 2021
 Conference, with responses due by fall of 2021. Standards need to include an additional section on emergency planning. Also needs additional members.
